Cigar Night with Santiago Cigars

Many of you have had a chance to talk with Deer Run's founder, George Kuyon during your visit to the winery. While chatting with George, it may have come up that he has an interest in cigars. George's interest pairs gracefully with Gary Liotta's interest in wine. Gary is the owner and president of [Santiago Cigar Factory, Inc.](#), and has served Deer Run wine at several of his events at his retail shop located at 412 State St., Rochester, NY.

Gary developed an interest in marrying wine and cigars, and has developed a process to infuse cigars with wine. He currently produces cigars infused with our Noiret, and our Dockside, which we carry in our tasting room. It became a logical next step to have a cigar event at the winery, so now is your chance to see how these two indulgences can complement each other.

Call the winery to purchase your \$15.00 ticket, which includes a Santiago Cigar, a glass of wine, free wine tasting, and hors d'oeuvres. A Santiago Cigar Factory master roller will be present to demonstrate cigar rolling techniques and roll a variety of premium cigars for purchase. Our Frontenac and Marechal Foch always ripen first, and the wildlife get (what we consider) more than their fair share.

This year, we've redoubled our efforts at wildlife control with extra fence wires (high to deter the deer and low to deter the raccoons and squirrels), extra bird scaring balloons, extra bird scaring wire, and our trusty old propane cannon.



Even with all of these efforts, the critters manage to get a portion, and we continue to grumble about it, though we know that it is inevitable. By the end of September, we will likely have picked the Frontenac and Marechal Foch and possibly another couple varieties as well, and will be able to begin sharing reports on quantity and quality with you.

For now, sugars are rising, acid is falling, and we are praying.
